I. ADVERTISEMENT

By this Request for Proposals, Whitaker Homes, LP (“Owner”) requests written proposals from construction materials testing firms (“Firm”) for the provision of concrete, soil and miscellaneous construction materials and quality control testing and inspection services for the construction of the Meade Village Development.

The Owner is rehabilitating and financing Meade Village which consist of Thirty (30) rehabilitated buildings, one (1) non-residential community, two (2) new buildings totaling 24 new construction units. The development is located at 1710 Meade Circle Road in Severn ,Maryland. Construction is scheduled to begin January 2020 and continue for a period of approximately fourteen (14) months. Estimated cost of construction is \$23,000,000.00.

This solicitation is in accordance with a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) that has been issued by the Owner. Proposals are to be received no later than by 2:00 p.m. on Friday November 8, 2019.

- C. All proposals must be received by 2:00 p.m. on Thursday November 8, 2019.
- D. Three (3) copies of the RFP must be presented. No telephone proposals will be accepted.
- E. Proposals should be prepared simply and economically, providing a clear and concise description of the respondent’s capabilities as well as a detailed fee schedule of proposed services to be rendered. Special bindings, colored displays, promotional materials, etc. are not desired. Emphasis should be on completeness and clarity of content.
- F. All proposals must include the following:
 - Specific company and individual **experience** relative to proposed project
 - **Certifications** of individuals that are planned to be working on the Project and their areas of expertise or responsibility
 - Minimum **qualifications** of those individuals who will serve as Inspection Agents to the Project must include the following:
 1. Professional Engineer (PE)
 2. American Concrete Institute Certified Concrete Field Testing Technician (ACI)
 3. American Welding Society Certified Welding Inspector (AWS)
 4. American Society of Non-Destructive Testing – Level II or III (ASNT)

 - **Sample of reports** that we would typically receive

The Owner also reserves the right to reject the response of any firm that has previously failed to perform satisfactorily, or has failed to complete on time, a contract or contracts of a similar nature.

2. The Owner reserves the right to negotiate with any respondent. The Owner also reserves the right to negotiate with the firm to amend and extend the contract issued under this solicitation.
3. All procurement decisions shall be at the sole discretion of the Whitaker Homes LP.
4. This procurement procedure and contract award are subject to regulations of the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and any applicable federal and State laws and regulations.
5. The Firm and the Owner will enter into a mutually acceptable form of agreement.

V. SCOPE OF WORK AND PROPOSED FEE SCHEDULE

Specific tests and inspections include but are not limited to the following: soil sampling, soil density compaction, rebar inspection, concrete slump test, concrete strength and placement test, structural steel welding inspection and non-destructive testing and bolting, masonry grout testing and observation, testing of wood construction materials (including framing and details, connections, material grading), testing of precast concrete planks, and testing of adhesive anchoring system. For your reference and use, included as attachments are the development site plan and grading plan.
